### Reduced Rates for Work Weekends

\$5 per person for age 4 and over (age 3 and under free)

#### Other Weekends or Weekdays

\$12 per adult (18+) per night, \$6 for ages 13-17, 12 and under free

Additional charge for use of cooking equipment, utilities, etc. of \$1 per adult per weekend if you do your own cooking. If we provide meals, Board charges will be: \$10.50 per adult (age 13 and over) per day; \$8 for 8-12, \$5 for 4-7, and age 3 and under free.





## CREATIVITY NEEDED




